

Vocabulary (2026)

Monday - A Big Problem and a Big Adventure (Adam, Eve, and Noah)

Obey	to follow God's commands
Sin	an act or thought against God's ways, to do something wrong, against God
Temptation	Wanting to do something you know is wrong. Being tempted is not sin, but giving into temptation (doing something wrong) is sin.
Faith	To believe or trust in. Faith means believing in God (Father, Son and Holy Spirit) even though you can't see God; you can depend on God.
Righteous	To obey God and honor Him
Repent	To turn from Sin and follow God
Confess	To admit your sins

Tuesday - An Impossible Escape (Moses)

Plague	Disasters or an awful happening
Sacrifice	Giving God something important to show your love and obedience to God
Miracle	An unusual event caused by God's power
Death	The end of life, lifeless. There is physical death to which everyone is subject. There is spiritual death which is separation from God and only those who do NOT believe in Jesus will be subject to spiritual death.

Wednesday - A Royal Risk (Esther)

Grace	Is not getting what you deserve. You deserve death because of your sins, but because of Jesus you can have eternal life if you make Him lord of your life. Similar to but not exactly like mercy
Justice	Getting what you deserve – that can be good or that can be bad
Mercy	Is getting what you don't deserve. You may deserve to be punished but mercifully you are not punished. Similar to but not exactly like grace.

Thursday - The Ultimate Love (Jesus)

Salvation	A free gift from God to save us from the effect of sin
Crucifixion	The method used to execute Jesus. It involved nailing someone to a cross resulting in a slow and painful death, Jesus' death on the cross made salvation possible for us
Resurrection	To come back to life and never die again. Only one person has been resurrected – Jesus Christ
Savior	Someone who rescues you from destruction. Jesus saves us from separation from God.
Baptism	Baptism is a sign that God is in charge of your life. You are dipped in the water to show that you are washed clean of your sins.
Disciple	A follower and student. Jesus had 12 disciples.

Friday - The Greatest Mission (Peter, Paul, and All of Us)

Apostle	After the resurrection of Jesus, his disciples were called Apostles. Apostle means messenger. They were taught by Him while he was on Earth.
Holy Spirit	The Holy Spirit helps us live and love like Jesus did. God is the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit.
Good News	The story of Jesus and his death/sacrifice and resurrection. Also, the message of salvation through Jesus Christ and the eternal Kingdom of God (similar to Gospel)
Repent	to turn from sin and follow God.
Confess	to tell or acknowledge something bad about yourself (similar to admit)
Respond	to react to God's call to accept / believe in Jesus' sacrifice and return to life, to accept Jesus as your savior
Admit	to state as true something bad about yourself (similar to confess)
Rise (Risen, Rose)	to return from the dead as Jesus has risen.
Gospel	the belief that because of Jesus' life, death and resurrection individuals can have a relationship with God and inherit eternal life. (similar to Good News)
